A parent or guardian must complete the required paperwork. Vaccines will be available for children birth through 18 years of age.

To be eligible for these immunizations, each child must be on Sooner Care, provide evidence of Native American heritage, or be uninsured.

BAN Gearing Up for Phase II

BAN's Board of Directors has determined that we are ready to embark upon a Phase II Capital Campaign to construct an addition to our existing facility. After almost 4 years in our new facility, we are already outgrowing it and looking to expand our working and storage space. School Supply Distribution

August 6 - 9, 2018 & August 13 - 16, 2018

Hours of Distribution:

Monday through Thursday 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM



Monday & Thursday 4:00 PM until 7 PM for clients who are employed and submit a current check stub

To be eligible for school supplies client files must be up-to-date with current photo ID's for all adults over 18 years of age, current proof of address, proof of income, and birth certificates/immunization records for children 18 years of age and younger.

Each child will receive a backpack with school supplies while they last. Please understand that school supplies will be distributed based on donations received. It is very possible that we may not have every item needed. We anticipate that you may have a bit of a wait time due to a high volume of clients during this time so we appreciate your patience.

If you desire to collect school supplies for our 2018 distribution, we are in need of the following supplies: pencils, colored pencils, markers, large erasers (pink), rulers, 2 pocket w/brad folders, and dry erase markers. These items can be delivered to BAN at 315 W. College St.

Even though our primary focus is to reduce food insecurity, we try to keep a limited amount of hygiene supplies on hand as well (deodorant and women’s hygiene items).
