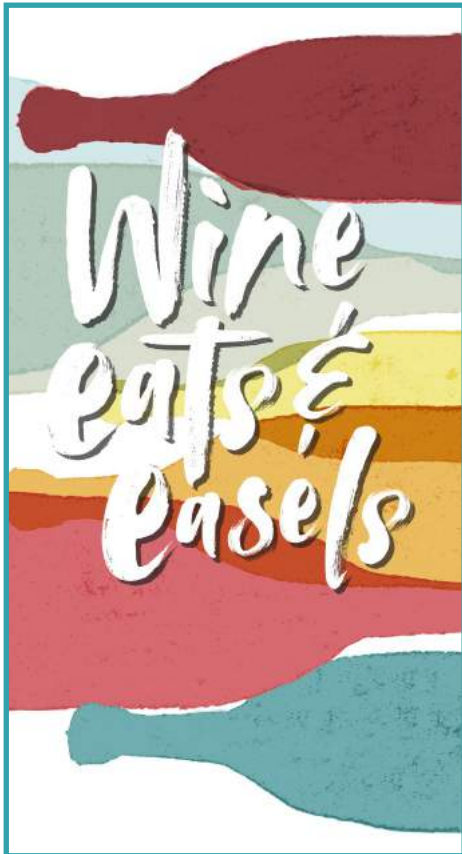




Thank You Broken Arrow!
